Citizens may address the Council but <u>all comments must be relevant to topics on the agenda</u>. Citizens' Participation <u>is not provided as a general forum</u> and is <u>not</u> a forum for support/opposition of publicly announced or declared candidates for public office/issues, as such, they will not be allowed to be discussed. Citizens will not be allowed to campaign on any political issue during the Council meeting. Comments must strictly concern specific Council actions or policies on the agenda. PLEASE LIMIT YOUR COMMENTS TO 2 MINUTES.

Special Considerations for Attendance at NorthCare:
