Citizens will not be allowed to campaign on any political issue during the Council meeting. Comments must strictly concern specific Council actions or policies on the agenda. **PLEASE LIMIT YOUR COMMENTS TO 2 MINUTES.** 

## Special Considerations for Attendance in an OKC Facility

<u>Because the room is in a public building</u>, all attendees agree to abide by the rules of decorum befitting a public building, including that all attendees should conduct themselves "in a dignified and orderly manner..." in accordance with all Facility Rules and Regulations or be removed from the premises.

## **Council Actions**

Official action can be taken only on items which appear on the agenda. <u>The Council may adopt, approve, ratify, deny, defer, recommend, amend, strike, or continue any agenda item.</u>

When more information is needed to act on an item, the Council may refer the matter to Staff. The Council may also refer items to standing committees of the Council for additional study. Under certain circumstances, items are deferred to a specific later date or stricken from the agenda entirely.
